
Environmental education models

Holistic environmental education consists of three components:

- Close relationship with nature

- Actions for the environment
 "I want to influence my own well-being and the well-being of others ..."
- Environmental insights "If I take only as much as I can eat on my plate, I won't produce waste and throw food unnecessarily in the trash."
